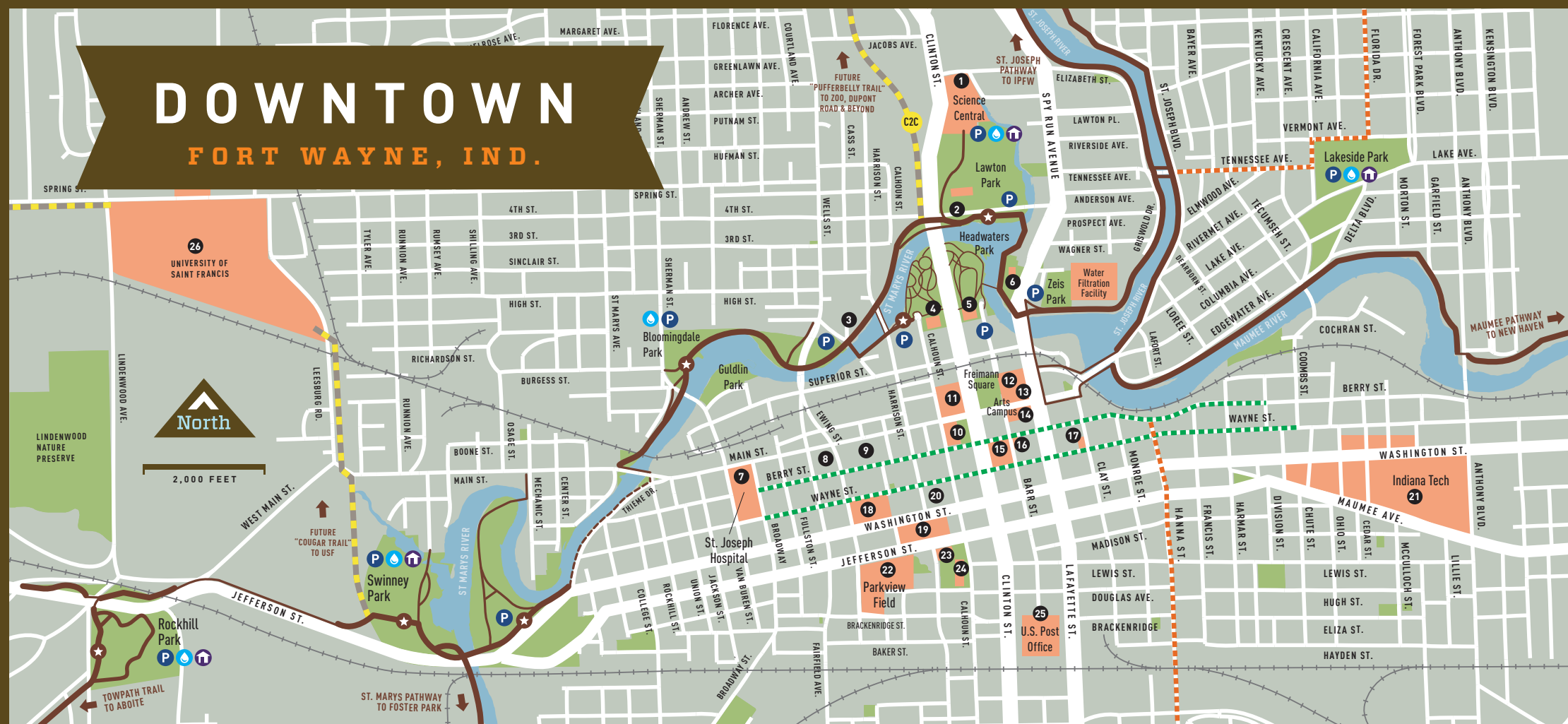

RULES OF THE TRAIL

- ▶ Keep to the right, pass on the left.
- ▶ Ring a bell or call out "on your left" prior to passing.
- ▶ Yield to slower trail users.
- ▶ Obey traffic signals and signage.
- ▶ Stop for cross traffic.
- ▶ Keep pets on short leashes.
- ▶ Animal waste must be removed from the trail.
- ▶ Never, ever litter.
- ▶ No motorized equipment except official and emergency vehicles and motorized wheelchairs.
